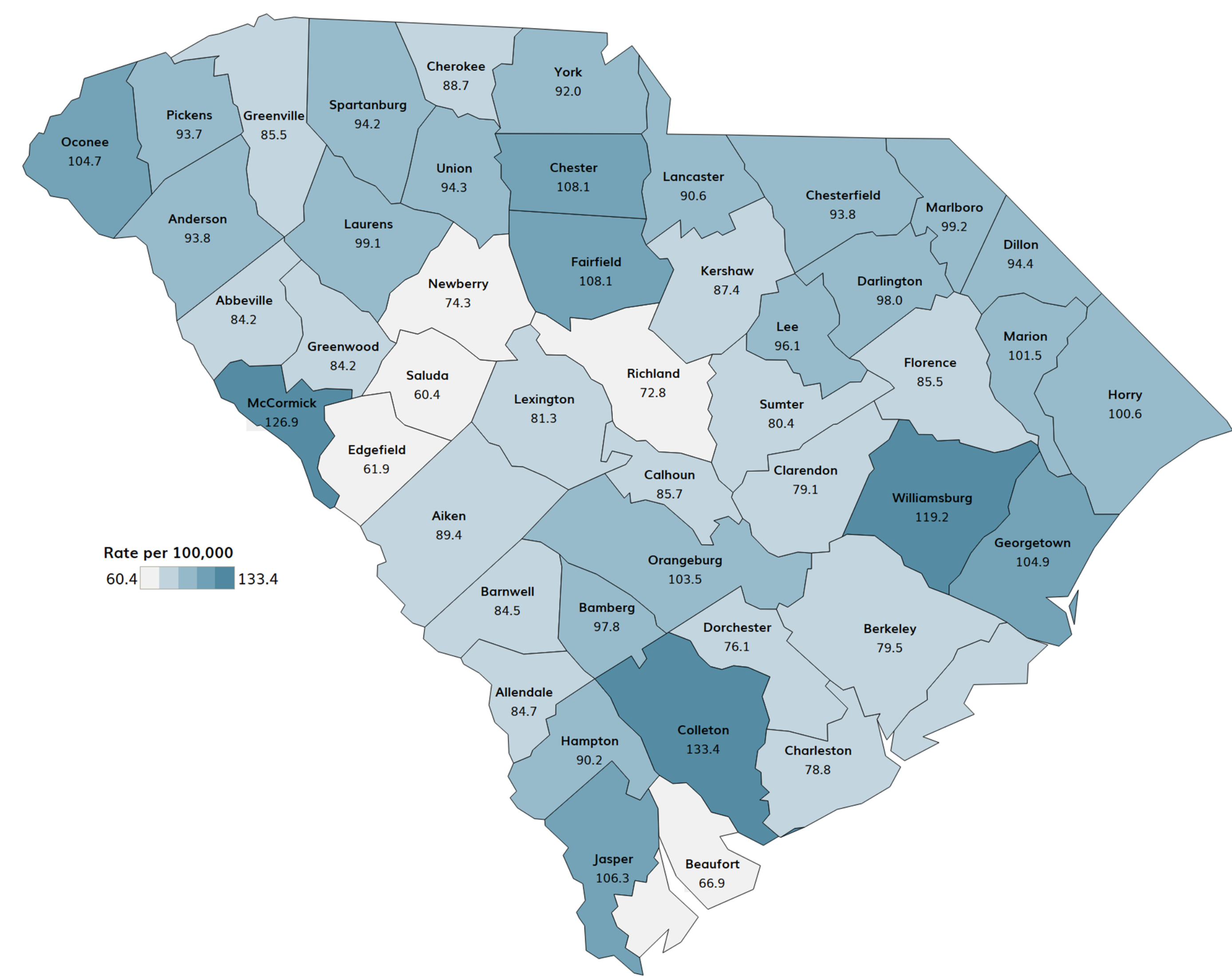

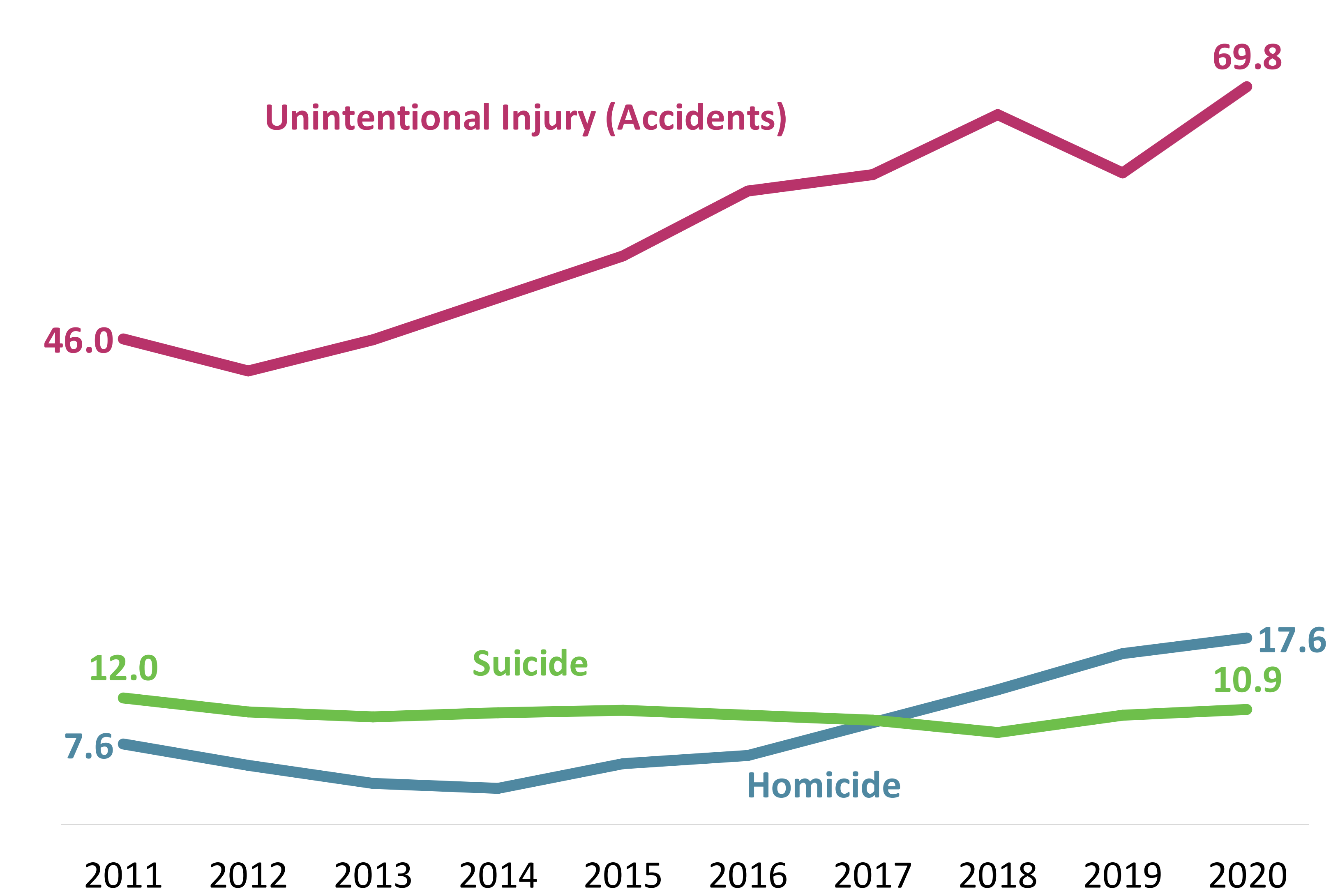
Overall Injury

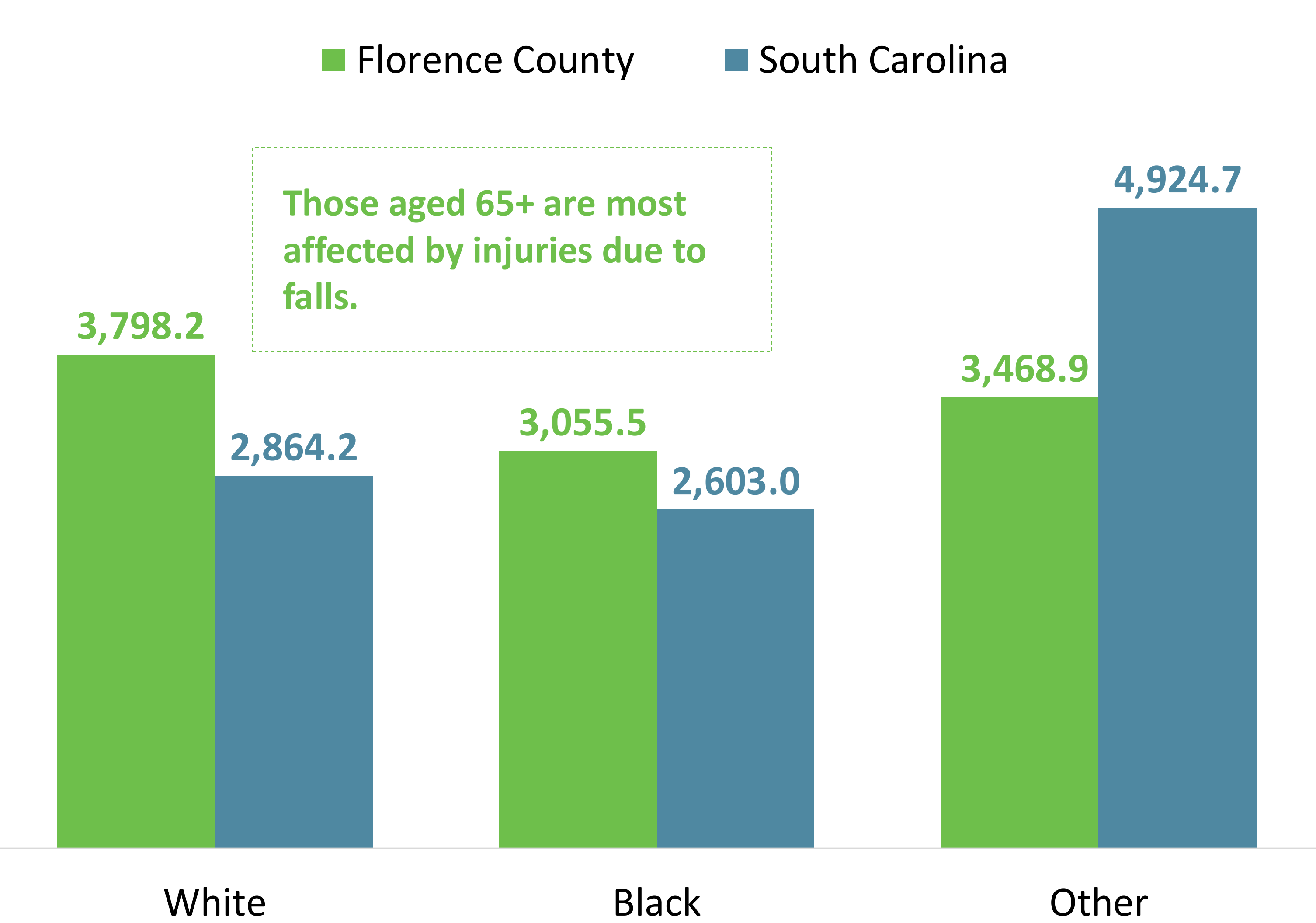

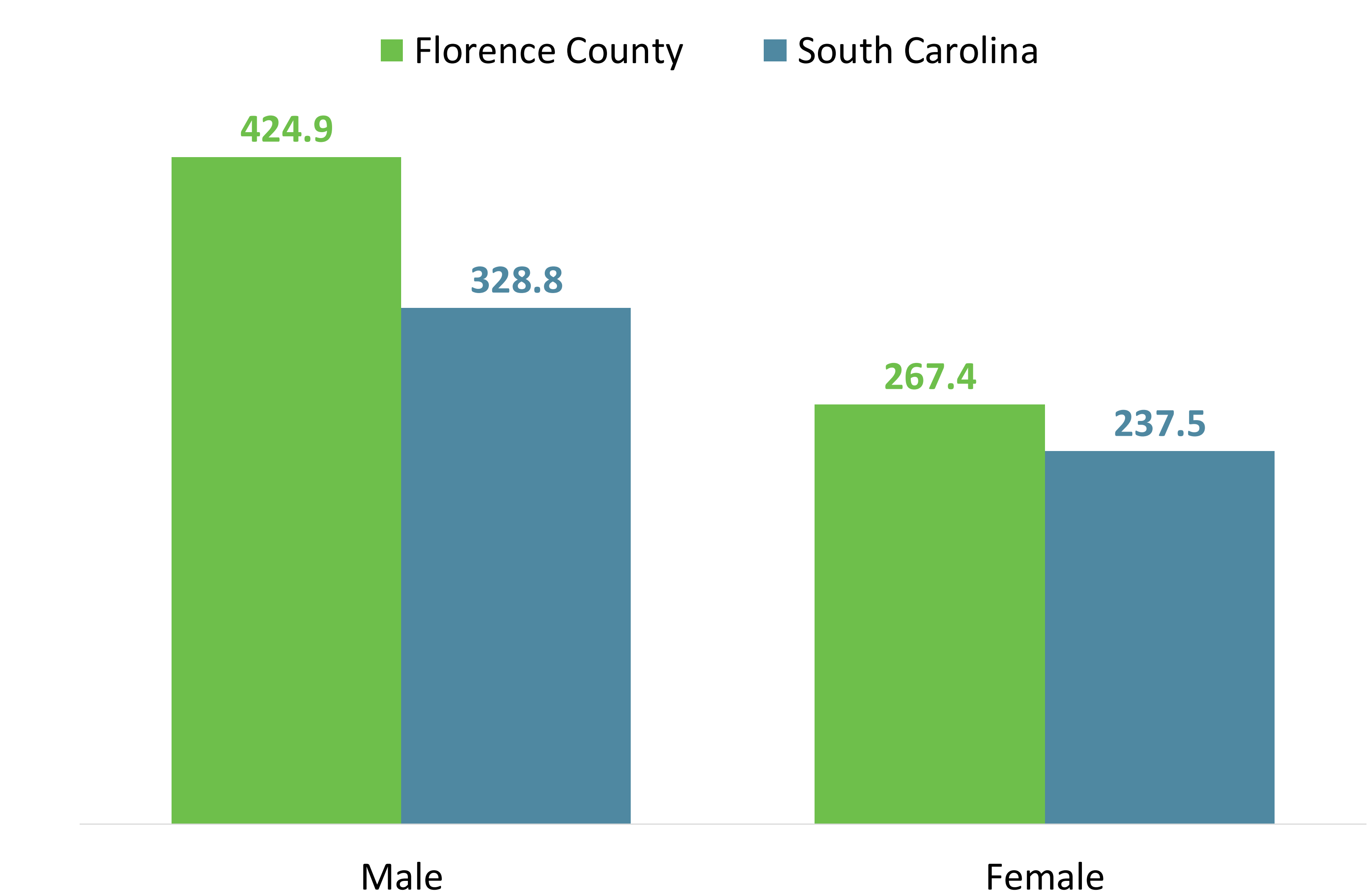

Rate per 100,000 population



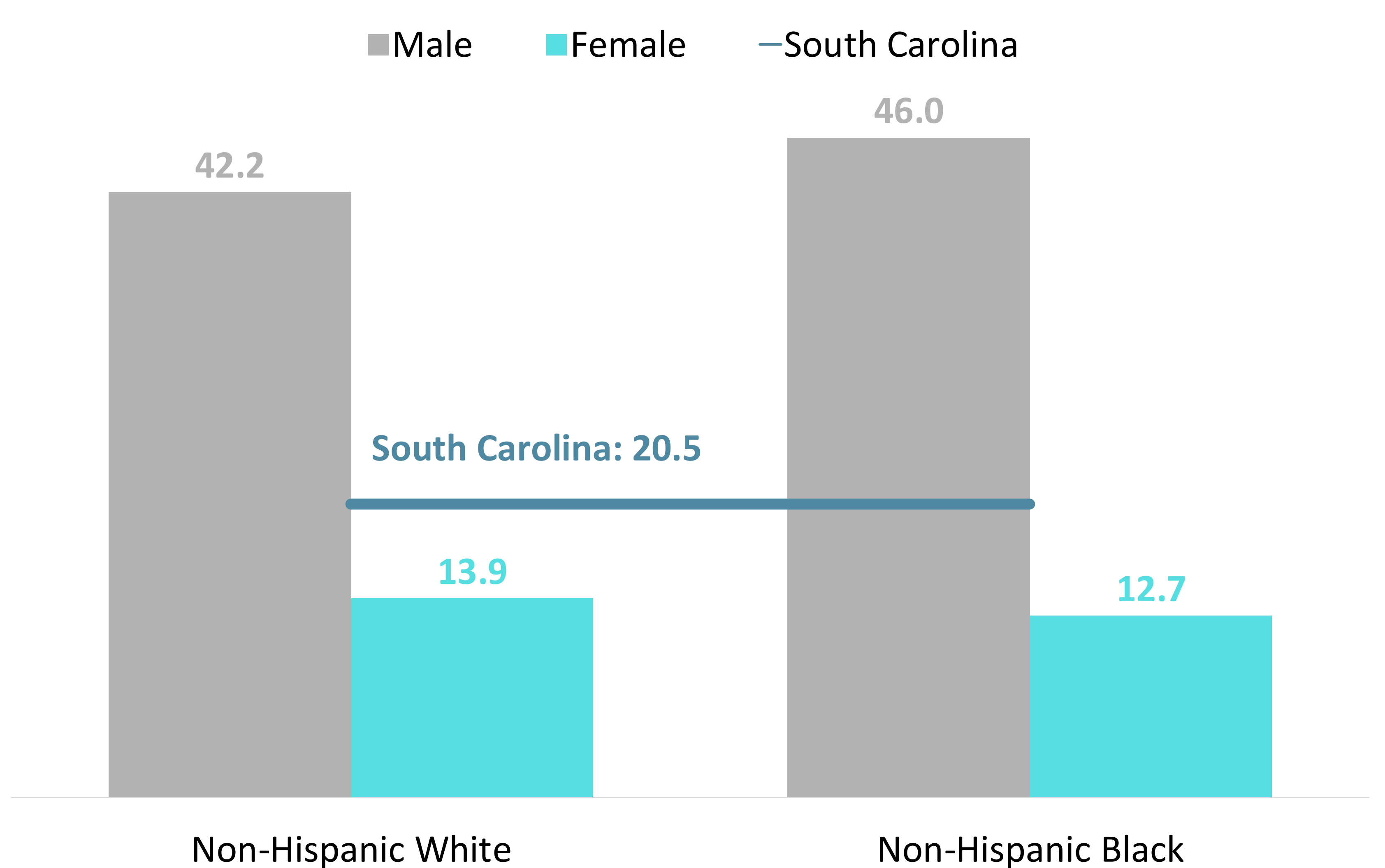
