You <u>may</u> qualify if you:

- Are a female South Carolina resident, aged 21 to 64
- **2** Have no health insurance, or have highdeductible health insurance (>\$1,000)
- **3** Have diagnostic insurance coverage less than 100%
- **4** Have hospitalization coverage only
- 5 Meet income guidelines (at or below 250% of the Federal Poverty Level)

8	\$131,800 or less
NOTE: For families/households with more than 8 persons, add \$13,450 for each additional person.	

The family size and income should be reviewed with the client annually and documented on the BCN enrollment form.
