- II. SUBJECT: Sanctions completed during the period November 1, 2011, through December 31, 2011.
- III. FACT: For the period November 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011, Health Regulation issued four (4) Consent Orders with total penalties of \$37,400.

IV. ANALYSIS: <u>Atlanta Dental Supply Company, 1650 Satellite Boulevard, Duluth, GA</u> <u>30097</u>. Under a Consent Order executed October 7, 2011, the Department imposed a \$12,600 monetary penalty with \$10,600 of the monetary penalty stayed upon an eighteen month period of compliance. The \$2,000 remaining payment was paid by the company. The company was found to have violated <u>Regulation 61-64, X-Ray</u>, for repeated failure to meet the service and installation requirements of x-ray equipment.

Previous Sanctions: None

<u>American Health, 905 North Pearl Street, Pageland, SC 29728</u>. Under a Consent Order executed November 9, 2011, the Department imposed a \$15,000 monetary penalty with \$13,500 of the monetary penalty stayed upon an eighteen month period of compliance. The \$1,500 remaining payment was paid by the facility. The facility was found to have violated <u>Regulation 61-64, X-Ray</u>, for failure to ensure that the x-ray equipment was operated only by qualified, trained individuals and for failure to monitor the x-ray operators.

Previous Sanctions: None

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> Family Residential Care Home II, 23 Edwards St., Sumter, SC 29150. Under a Consent Order executed August 8, 2011, the Department imposed a \$500 monetary penalty with \$300 of the monetary penalty stayed upon a three month period of substantial compliance. The \$200 remaining payment was paid by the facility. The facility was found to have violated <u>Regulation</u> <u>61-84</u>, <u>Standards for Licensing Community Residential Care Facilities</u>, for failure to have a staff member present in the facility while residents were present in the facility.

Previous Sanctions: None

Northwood Senior Living and Memory Care, 1267 North Main Street, Sumter, SC 29153. Under a Consent Order executed December 9, 2010, the Department imposed a \$9,300 monetary penalty. Of the penalty, \$3,216.14 was paid to the Department. The remaining \$6,083.86 was used by the facility for consultation and in-house training. The consultation and training was required to focus on medication administration, notes and observations, training for special needs, and other areas that have a direct effect on resident care. The facility was found to have violated <u>Regulation 61-84</u>, <u>Standards for Licensing Community Residential Care Facilities</u>, for failure to have staff background checks, staff training, and documentation of patient medications or patient tests, and others. Many of these violations were repeat violations.
