|                                   | Rather than a new spinal trauma protocol,<br>the pediatric head trauma protocol was<br>repurposed to include head and spine<br>trauma and direct EMS to consider spinal<br>motion restriction based on history and<br>mechanism. References inserted to<br>consider NAT. Further clarification<br>provided for mechanism and injury patters<br>that would warrant spinal restriction.<br>Special Considerations reviewed with the<br>group. Spinal Motion Restriction defined.<br>Acceptable devices listed. Additional<br>trauma protocols with spinal restriction<br>considerations shared for reference and for<br>additional comment from the group. Group<br>discussed high risk auto to further define.<br>Decision was made to include language in<br>box 3 of pediatric triage and transport<br>protocol. Group agreed to update per<br>recommendations. |       |

| EMSC/DHEC Updates | EMS Regulations: Waiting for the end of<br>May for 61.7 to publish to the State<br>Register. Found favorable by reviewing<br>committees.<br>Rich W. recommended a change to the<br>Pediatric Trauma Triage and Transport<br>Protocol. Proposed to move burns greater<br>than superficial to Box 2. The group asked<br>for further definition of burns and an added<br>asterisk for proximity to burn centers. A<br>recommendation was made to follow state<br>burn transport guidelines and cross<br>reference between the protocols. The group<br>agreed to move it with more clarifying<br>language to be added. |       |
